All local vendors are invited to Meridian's McFadden Market Co-op Farmers' Market!

Tuesdays from 5:00-8:00 p.m. from April 28, 2009 – October 27, 2009

Saturdays, November 14, 21; December 5, 12, 19 are other possible dates.

The McFadden Market Co-op is located at the Meridian City Hall parking lot on Main and Broadway Avenue, Meridian.

McFadden Market is looking for local vendors who plan to sell produce, plants, meat, cheese, coffee, tea, baked goods and art. There will be local musicians, ideas on "green living" and educational projects for children! This will be a great opportunity for producers and growers to connect with the community!

We hope to see you there!

Each vendor is responsible for:

- Sales permit to be displayed in booth-for information contact The Idaho State Tax Commission-334-7660
- All food/drinks must be pre-approved by the Central District Health Department, Irene Mansfield 327-7499.
- No alcohol permitted
- All necessary equipment for operation of booth-tents or canopies must be secured appropriately
- Vendors are responsible for electrical and water; some electrical available.
- Trash removal is the responsibility of vendors
- Vendor fee \$25.00 for the season for 10X10space/\$50 for 20X10space
- 6% of sales each market day to McFadden Market Co-op

- \$3.00 service fee each market day (for first 4 markets.)
- Set up time between 9-9:45a.m. on Saturdays, 4-4:45 p.m. on Tuesdays

At least 75% of every item sold needs to be locally grown, baked, or made by the vendor. Items for sale may include vegetables, fruits, potted plants, cut and dried flowers, other agricultural products, prepared foods, and handcrafted items grown or made within a 100-mile radius of Meridian, Idaho. Produce may not be advertised as “organic” unless it has been certified organic with the Department of Agriculture. A current organic certification must be displayed.

A trial period of two markets is allowed prior to payment of the administration fee. The yearly membership fee must be paid on or before your first sales at the 3rd market.

Vendors are responsible for complying with all applicable rules and regulations and obtaining a posting the necessary permits and licenses, e.g. sales tax license. Health department license numbers must be provided to the McFadden Market Co-op Market Manager.

Vendors must obtain their own liability insurance and provide evidence to the market manager. Processed food vendors must add the McFadden Market Co-op as a certificate holder and provide us a copy prior to their first market day.

Vendors will maintain a clean and orderly booth and remove all trash from their market area. Be sure to sweep up your area before leaving.

No smoking by vendors in the market area. No open alcoholic beverage allowed on premises. No vendor’s animals allowed in the market area except Service Animals such as Seeing Eye dogs. Children of vendors must be under control of their parent or guardian at all times.

No soliciting by charitable or activist group in any area of the market.

The Market Manager is the first and final authority at the market and may deny market privileges to anyone who has not complied with market rules or food regulations.
